1. **Martial Arts** : This is compulsory for every students/pupils of Lagos Muslim International School. It comes up on Wednesdays for the primary section and Thursdays for the secondary section. The activity for each day is handled by a trained and certified TAEKWONDO instructor. The purpose of it is basically for self-defense.

2. **Young Farmer's Club**: This club is not compulsory for all students/pupils. It is only available for the interested students/pupils of Lagos Muslim International School. The objective of this club is to give our future farmers practical knowledge of what farming activities entail, because in LAMIS, we know the importance of farmers in our nation building. The practical aspects of this are done on the school's piece of land which is directly opposite the primary school building at Clem Road, Jankara Lagos.

3. **Egbe Akomolede**: This club is purposely set up in the school with the aim of promoting our indigenous culture which do not conflict with our religious beliefs. In other to achieve these objectives, it is mandatory for every staff and student/pupil of Lagos Muslim International School to converse in Yoruba language on Wednesdays and more emphasis are laid in class during Yoruba Studies sessions.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

- Parents who wish that their children should sit for entrance examination must obtain an application form by paying a certain amount into the schools account.
- Students must fill and submit the form before the entrance examination date.
- The secretary will communicate with the parents the examination dates.
- Within a week, candidates that are successful will be notified by text messages and phones calls.
- The details of school life, school calendar, uniform, lists of books and so on will be given to successful candidate after payment.
- It is compulsory for all the new students/pupils to pay hundred percent of the school fees on or before resumption.

- A student place is confirmed upon payment of the minimum deposit within the deadline in th admission letter.

The Primary School

The primary school section is a continuation of the excellence achieved at the preparatory/Nursery section. The school is approved by the Lagos State Government, Ministry of Education, Office of Education Quality Assurance.



This approval is a testimony to the structured and well planned academic excellence of school.

This primary section is divided into lower primary and upper primary with effective monitoring and teaching of the pupils. Each classes of the lower primary is managed by two teachers because of the peculiar needs of pupils in these classes. The upper primary classes have subject teachers for their respective subjects.

LOWER PRIMARY (BASIC 1-BASIC 3)

Our curriculum for these classes is centered on the Lagos State Government and Federal Curricula. These curricula are combined to broaden their horizons. All the listed subjects, in each curriculum are taught in a very conducive environment.

UPPER PRIMARY (BASIC 4-BASIC 6)

Here, our curriculum takes into cognizance not only the State requirement for the State common Entrance Examination but also the Federal Examination into their various Federal Government Colleges.



The Basic 6 pupils are registered for the common Entrance Examination for the award of the First School Leaving Certificate.

Our curriculum is designed towards achieving the aims and objectives of the school by putting the core values as well as the vision into the academic consideration.

PUPILS ASSESSMENT

The exercise is very germane to overall evaluation of the pupils. They are frequently assessed right from beginning of the term. By the fourth week, pupils will have a general mini assessment on the topics covered for each subjects. Reports are sent to parents and feedback are received and assessed for necessary corrections.

Generally speaking, this section of the school has served as the eyes through which the vision of the school is being pursued and has being responsible for the progress of the school.

This is because of the quality of teachers and professional tutors with affective output methodologies in classroom management.

The school operates on special standard of international levels that is why we have been competing favourably not only within but also with schools outside the country.



The College



The College, students study the fourteen subjects contained in the Lagos State curriculum: English, Mathematics, Basic Science, Basic Technology, ICT, Business Studies, Cultural and Creative Arts, Civic Education, Yoruba, Physical and Health Education, Islamic Religious Studies, Pre-vocational (Home Economics and Agricultural Science) and Security Education.

Lagos Muslim International College is approved by the Lagos State Ministry of Education – Office of Education Quality Assurance, West African Examination Council and National Examination Council to present JSS3 and SS3 students for Basic Education certificate Examination and senior secondary certificate examination.

In J.S.S.3(BASIC 9), Students are registered into the National Examinations, the Basic Education Certificate Examination, BECE, for the award of Junior School Certificate.

THE SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS (YEAR 10-12) S S 1 – S S 3 (AGE 14-16)

Our curriculum is centered on the Nigerian requirement of the West African Education Council, WAEC and The National Examination Council, NECO. Also, our curriculum enriches students to explore the world after school and to become citizens who are positive influencers contributing to the lives of others and the society at large.

STUDENTS ASSESSMENT/EVALUATION

This is an essential part of teaching. We make sure that students are continuously assessed. At the of fourth week, student have a mini assessment on the subject matter covered during 1,2 and 3rd week, they are then given feedback and teachers re-teach and do correction as required.

At the end of the term, the students are assessed and all assessment are recorded and provide parents with evidence of each ward progress.

Special Educational Needs

As a school, we are committed to provide the best education for every student if there is a learning difficulty or a student is not learning at the same pace with other students, we can identify that by tracking the student progress and look for a way to give the student additional support to enable him/her to reach his/her full potential.
